Each animal represents *daily* handling, routine-based training, and real-world exposure — including hands-on interaction with people in different environments — making them uniquely suited for public-facing, therapeutic, and agritourism environments. DONKEYS

They work comfortably in active farm environments and have proven livestock-protection awareness while remaining exceptionally gentle with guests. Their striking white color photographs beautifully and has made them a favorite for events and agritourism settings.


